The Chinese government summoned Japan's ambassador to lodge a protest after a cabinet minister visited the Yasukuni Shrine, which it said symbolizes Japanese militarism

- (January 1938) Prolong war against Japan
- CCP: guerrilla warfare (positional)
- CCP: infiltration & attacking rear areas
- KMT: traditional warfare
- KMT: worries about CCP in North ("high alert" for warlords & communists)
- CCP spreads its message as fights
- CCP exceeds peasant expectations

Abe's offering was no different from visiting in person. The paper said his move had hurt the feelings of Asian nations and challenged the current international order by harking back to the spirit of nationalism. The author's name, Zhong Sheng, is a pseudonym meaning "Voice of China", the paper said.
