- 5. How does the author argue that while Japan "may have" exploited the region, it should not be viewed as an absolute aggressor?
- 6. According to the article, how do certain foreign officials praise/support/promote Japan's actions in Manchuria?
- 7. Summarize the development of rice production/output.
